<b>300</b>	<b>Rescue/EMS Incidents including vehicle accidents, water rescue, searches, and industrial rescues.</b>
<b>400</b>	<b>Hazardous Materials Incidents including combustibile spills, radioactive &amp; biological, and electrical issues.</b>
<b>500</b>	<b>Service Incidents including water removal, smoke/odor issue, animal issue, and public service.</b>
<b>600</b>	<b>Good Intent Incidents including unknown type of alarms, controlled burns, steam mistaken for smoke.</b>
<b>700</b>	<b>False Alarm Incidents including unintentional fire alarms.</b>
<b>800</b>	<b>False Alarm Incidents including malicious alarms, bomb scares.</b>
<b>900</b>	<b>Special Incidents including citizen complaints, special types and miscellaneous incidents.</b>

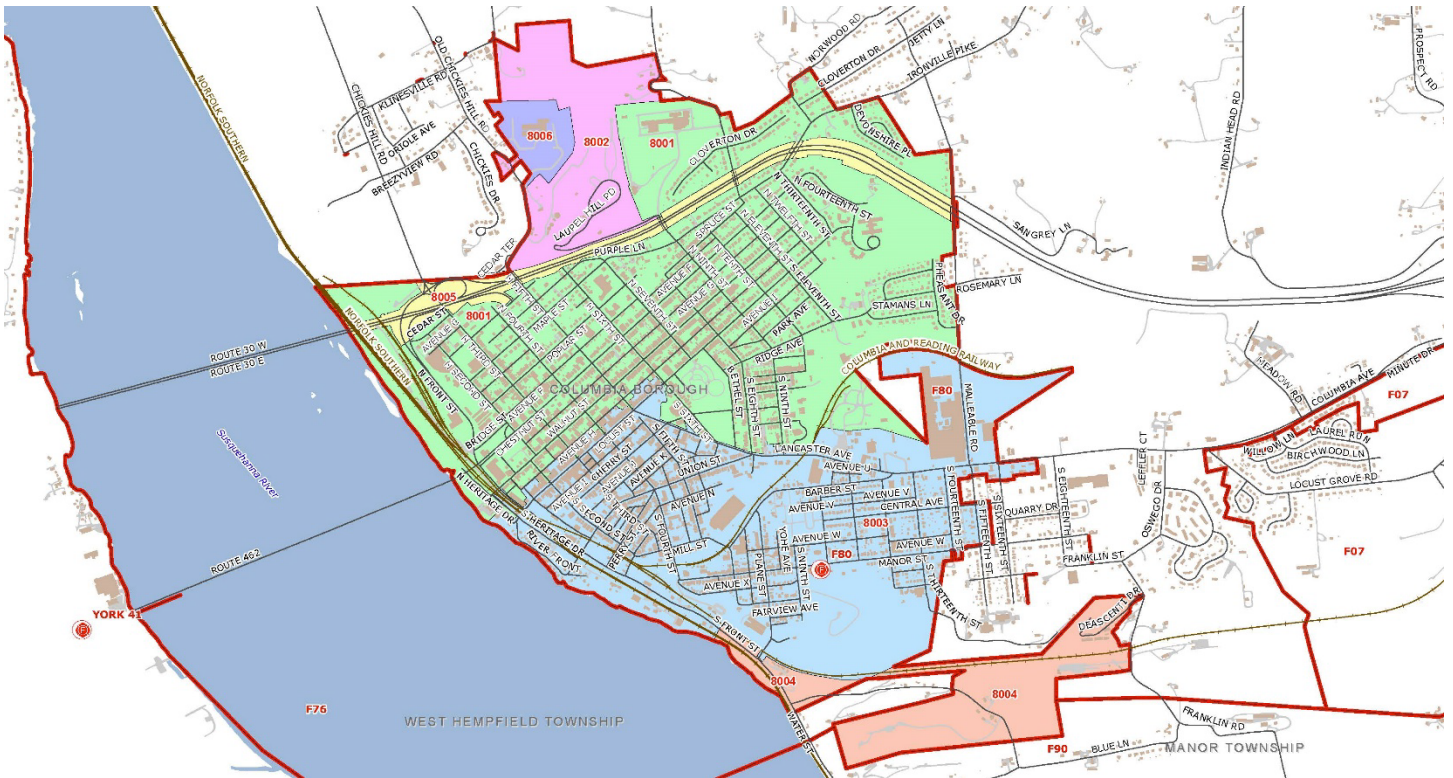
### APRIL INCIDENTS:

- 73 classes were attended for 278 volunteer man-hours.
- 57 activities were attended for 348 volunteer man-hours.
- Tuesday was our busiest day with 13 incidents.
- Incidents by shifts and our average number of volunteers:
  - 07:00am – 02:59pm 21 incidents.
  - 03:00pm – 10:59pm 32 incidents.
  - 11:00pm – 06:59am 6 incidents.
  - All Shifts 59 incidents.
- False Alarm was our most dispatched incident type with 16.
